GROUND / OPERATIONS RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assist Heads groundskeeper with day-to-day stadium maintenance and grounds

Field mowing and infield preparation

- Chalking, edging, dragging, nail dragging, watering, fertilizing and irrigation, adding infield materials and patching game mound, bullpens and home plate

Daily stadium clean up responsibilities

- Manage post game trash pick and stadium blow down
- Oversee hourly cleaning crew
- Mowing and weed eating grounds
- Upkeep of grounds equipment
- Perform duties in game with promotional team
- Other duties as assigned
